## Modal verb Should

Cuando queremos hablar acerca del cambio climático, o la naturaleza en si, no podemos pasar por alto el verbo modal Should – pronunciado "shud" – Ya que siempre nos será útil para dar consejos, y por ende evitar conductas indebidas de personas en relación a su entorno.





We use should or shouldn't to give positive or negative advice.

Positive

You **should** eat ...

She **should** eat ...

Negative: should + not = shouldn't

You **shouldn't** eat ...

She **shouldn't** eat ...

**Should** I eat ...?

**Should** she eat ...?

**SHOULD + verb**

Short answers

Yes, you **should**.

No, she **shouldn't**.

You should exercise every day. = It's a good idea to exercise every day.

You shouldn't eat fast food. = It's **not** a good idea to eat fast food.

Should I watch TV all the time? = Is it a good idea to watch TV all the time?

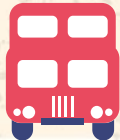
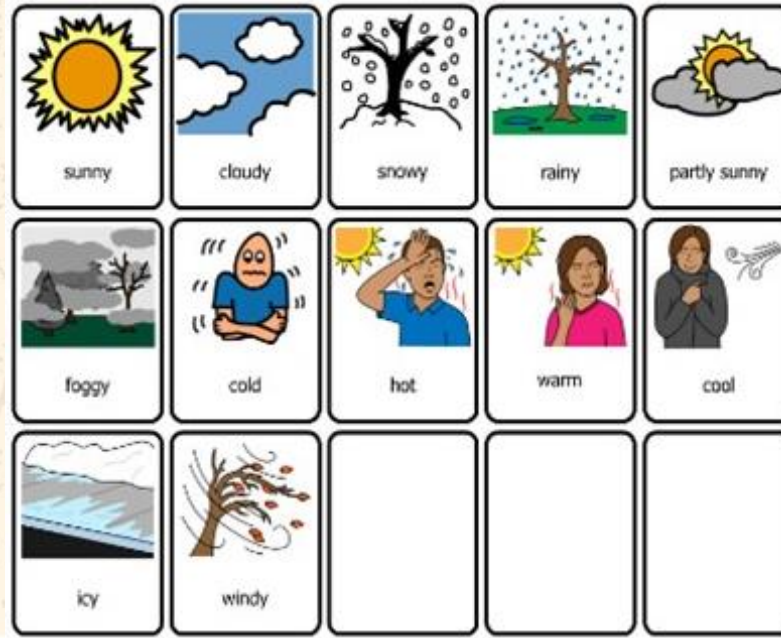




Observe la siguiente imagen referente a tipos de clima

It is...	It was...	It will be...

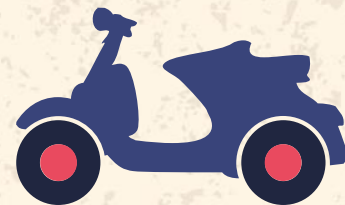
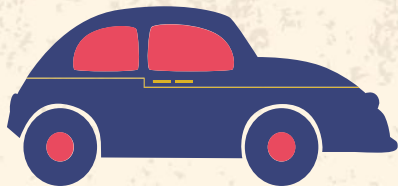
