Use of Should and So

Vocabulary



SHOULD/ SHOULDN'T

SUBJECT + SHOULD + VERB (present) *I should clean my bedroom.*

SUBJECT + SHOULDN'T + VERB (present) *I shouldn't take your mobile phone to school.*

SHOULD + SUBJECT + VERB (present) ? *Should you take the camera?*



- We use **SHOULD/ SHOULDN'T** (in negative) to **give advice and recommend something**.

She **should** learn english to go to England. (*ella hauria d'aprendre anglès per anar a Anglaterra.*)

- After **SHOULD**, don't put **'TO'**.

CORRECT: I **should** study everyday. (*Jo hauria d'estudiar tots els dies.*)

I **shouldn't** go to bed so late. (*Jo no hauria d'anar-me'n a dormir tard.*)

INCORRECT: I ~~should~~ **to** study everyday.

I ~~shouldn't~~ **to** go to bed so late.

- All SUBJECTS (I, YOU, HE, SHE, IT, WE, YOU, THEY) conjugate the same.



I should pay more attention.	HE should pay more attention.	WE should pay more attention.
YOU should pay more attention.	SHE should pay more attention.	YOU should pay more attention.
	IT should be open everyday. (museum, library, ...)	THEY should pay more attention.

LINKING WORDS

BUT

- Use but to show contrast.
- I usually walk to school but my dad drove me today

OR

- Use or to show a choice
- You can finish your homework now or you can finish it later

YET

- Use yet to join two ideas that are opposites
- He likes her, yet she doesn't like him

FOR

- Use for to show the reason
- I drank some juice, for I was thirsty

AND

- Use and to join sentences that show a similar idea
- Sally stayed home, and I watched TV

SO

- Use so to show the result of something
- We were hungry, so we ordered some food
